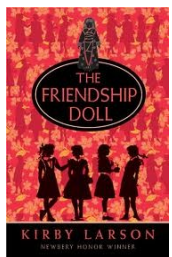
### Hattie Big Sky- Paperback

Hattie faces frost, drought and blizzards, but she forges ahead, sharing her adventures with her friends--especially Charlie, fighting in France--through letters and articles for her hometown paper. Her backbreaking quest for a home is lightened by her neighbors, the Muellers. But she feels threatened by pressure to be a "Loyal" American, forbidding friendships with folks of German descent. Despite everything, Hattie's determined to stay until a tragedy causes her to discover the true meaning of home.



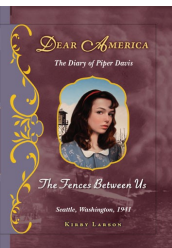
### Hattie Ever After- Hardback

In 1919, seventeen-year-old Hattie leaves the Montana prairie--and her sweetheart Charlie--to become a female reporter in San Francisco.



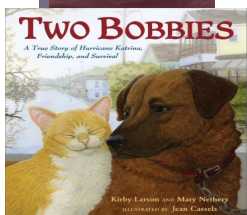
### The Friendship Doll- Paperback

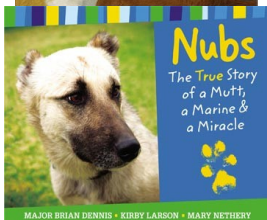
### Dear America (the Fences Between Us)- Hardback
