How Auction Night Works

Parking

Complimentary Self-Parking is available in the Lincoln Square parking garage. Please park on level P4 or P5 near the South Elevators and take the elevator up to the hotel lobby. Valet Parking is available at the front door of the Westin Bellevue Hotel for a fee.

Check-In

When you arrive, please proceed up the escalator to the second floor Check-In area to receive your auction catalog, table assignment and bid number bracelet. A bid number is assigned to each registered guest/couple. Large bid cards will be waiting for you at your assigned table. At Check-In, you will be asked to provide a credit card. All purchases made on March 11, 2017 will be charged to your account. Your information will be encrypted and electronically vaulted for your security. We accept VISA, MasterCard, AmEx and Discover.

Wear your bid bracelet to keep your bid number handy when you participate in games, raffles and bid on silent items. Use of your bid number indicates your agreement to abide by all stated auction rules.

Silent Auction Items

To place a bid, write your bid number on the Silent Auction bid sheet next to the amount you wish to bid. Please write legibly. Once a section has closed, no further entries will be allowed, and a Silent Auction official will collect the bid sheets. **Please do not remove items from Silent Auction tables.** Auction night personnel will collect items from the Silent Auction areas after bidding for each section has ended. These items will be held in the Check-Out and Pick-Up area.

Sign-Up Items

These special experience events such as *Midnight Bowling for 16* are *first come, first win*! So, get there early and sign up before all the slots are taken!

Almost Live Items

These are special experiences that we just didn't quite have room for in the LIVE auction, but are as equally amazing! These items will have a starting bid and will be sold to the highest bidder at the closing of the gold table.



Premium Wine Table

Premium wines are being sold at fixed prices with all proceeds going to Newcastle Elementary PTSA. You can choose to have the wine delivered to your table for enjoyment during the Live Auction and dinner or held at Item Pick-Up to take home with you. Included will be a wide range of beautiful wines to suit your individual tastes!

Live Auction Items

The Live Auction will occur in the Ballroom during dinner. You may bid on the Live Auction items by holding your bid number high with the number facing the auctioneer. You are the successful bidder when the auctioneer says, "SOLD," and acknowledges your bid number. A volunteer will then ask you to sign an acknowledgement form. This form constitutes a legal contract to buy. In the event of any dispute between bidders, the auctioneer shall have sole and final discretion to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer the item in dispute.

Classroom Art Projects

Classroom art projects will be on display in the Foyer. Bidding for all Class Projects will occur as part of the Live Auction.

Check-out and Item Pick-Up

At the end of the evening simply proceed to the Check-out area to collect your items. All auction items must be removed the evening of the auction. There will be an option to expedite the process by utilizing the "Self Check-out" process. More information will given at the conclusion of the live auction. A detailed receipt will be emailed to you upon completion of Check-out. **Cash payment is not accepted.** If you pay by check or do not purchase items on auction night, your vaulted credit card information will be voided.

Note

Value




