Presidents' Note

What a busy autumn season we have experienced! We have held two PTSA General Membership Meetings with lively discussion on budget questions but ultimately the approval of our 2016-2017 PTSA Budget and even the latest iteration of our PTSA Mission and Goals. The Board has been working to do some strategic planning to be certain that our PTSA reflects the needs and interests of our current student body, school staff, and administration while looking ahead to create financial safeguards so we can continue to provide resources that benefit students!

Already this year, we've paid out the monies collected for the School Supply Fees (\$30k), Educational Assistants [EAs] who help within classrooms or with small groups outside of the classroom (\$40k), provided Teacher, Staff, and Grade Level Allotments (\$19k), to name just a few. We've also had our Fall Auction Raffle, with Mr. Miller, Mrs. Posten, and Mrs. Robinson competing on-stage at the fun-tastic PTSA Costume Carnival! Mr. Miller and Mrs. Robinson tied in the "pie eating" contest, and Mrs. Posten's class sent in the most votes, so this truly was a winning event!

But not everything the PTSA does is about a dollar amount. One of the things your PTSA leadership is committed to is helping to connect our families together. Fathers of kindergarteners recently utilized the KinderConnect chairs to reach out and invite dads for an informal Dads' Night Out. We've organized Grade-Level Movie & Potluck (where everyone brings some food) events starting in November to reduce the number of people gathered in The Commons and increase the likelihood of connecting with other families with similar-aged children. (Who knows? Maybe some carpools will form and drop-off and pick-up will be less congested!) We hope you'll be there!




