Mrs. De Jesus's 3rd Grade Class

This stunning piece of glass art is comprised of twenty glass panels that together represent a map view of the City of Newcastle, centered on Newcastle Elementary. Students worked individually or with a partner to create buildings from cut glass pieces, borders from glass stringers, and landscape and pavement out of fine and coarse frit. Students followed contours of a drawing beneath glass panels, but personalized the scenery with choices in frit size and color and even embellished landscaping with colorful flowers. Pieces were loaded into the kiln for a partial fuse firing, leaving texture and relief on this map that includes the golf course and Lake Boren Park as well as the school and nearby houses. Backing frame is custom-built and stained to showcase the montage created by the students of Mrs. De Jesus, who completed the final panel for the project. This piece truly represents a collective effort by this energetic class!

"Holding Hands" Raku Pottery Bowl
Mrs. Hirshberg's 1st Grade Class

Raku ware is a type of pottery characterized by its iridescent luster and smoky smell. Unlike traditional pottery, the piece is fired in an outdoor raku kiln and removed while still glowing red hot to be placed in a metal container filled with combustible material such as newspaper. Closing the container reduces the oxygen, which creates the metallic effect.

The students traced their hands onto slab-rolled clay and decorated them using a variety of stamps and tools then wrote their names on them. The damp clay was then molded into the shape of a bowl and allowed to dry.

This piece is decorative, rather than functional, and is a piece of art that complements most décor.
