

The Select basketball season is rapidly approaching and tryouts will be held the week of September 25th. Exact times and locations can be found in the tables below. You will need to print, sign and deliver the linked <u>Registration, Release and</u> <u>Medical Release Form</u> and the <u>Concussion Awareness Form</u> from the Liberty Select web site (<u>www.libertyselectbasketball.com</u>). No player will be allowed to tryout without a signed form.

ETL and PSTL teams will be formed and players notified by September 30th. Cascade teams and coaches will be confirmed by the following week. Tryouts will be closed to parents and players only need to attend one tryout but it's preferred if they attend both. Coaches will use independent evaluators to help select teams.

Players need to bring WATER and a BASKETBALL with their name on them to the tryouts.

Working Together The Liberty Select Boys and Girls programs are now operating as one organization called Liberty Select Basketball Association. Both programs have unified as one legal 501(c)3 non-profit entity. The interim Board of Directors has been working hard to standardize processes, obtain non-profit status, finalize budget, confirm coaching staffs, schedule tryouts and parent meetings, solidify philosophy, and general administration tasks. Some of the changes you'll notice for the 2011-2012 season are:

The interim board will become official during an open meeting to all Liberty Select members on September 20th at Bellevue Fire Station Nine (12412 Newcastle Way) at 7pm. The board is also looking for new members who would like to join.

Coaching ETL and PSTL coaches for the 2011-2012 season have been confirmed. Cascade coaches will be confirmed once the teams are formed. We are pleased to add two paid coaches to our roster for this coming season. The 7th Grade Boys and 8th Grade Girls will be the first teams in our program to pursue this option. The program will look to add additional paid coaches in future years.

Cost Select fees for ETL and PSTL teams will be \$375 per player. Two teams will have an additional coaching fee of \$100 to fund our new paid coaches. Cascade select fees will be \$275 per player. The player fee covers league fees, training, tournament fees, gym fees for games and practices, uniforms, insurance, referees and spirit wear. The fee will be collected at the parent meeting which will take place in the first week of October.
