- a. Grant for 5th Grade Create your own mixture, for up to \$250. Request from Ms.Kassuba for all of the 5th grade class. Bisa motioned to approve the \$250 Grant for 5th grade art project, Anand seconds. All ayes. Grant approved.
- b. Grant for 3rd grade \$1500 board approved for field trip to the Cougar Mt Zoo via email. Approved.
- c. Grant for scholastic/line Items Grade K,1 (554\$),2 (524\$),3,5 bill submitted for \$2,260. Entire scholastic for school included in the grant figure except for 4th grade. Going forward board motions to include this recurring item as a line item in the budget.

  - ii. Discussion regarding remaining \$10,000 grant budget K, 1, 2, 4 and 5 teachers may each get 1000\$ for the rest of the year, 3rd grade already had their approved budget.
- d. After School Programs all programs currently running
  - i. Sponge Spanish
  - ii. Leap4Kidz Lego
  - iii. Chess
  - iv. Robotics had low enrollment so vendor opted to cancel the program
- e. Playworks program only provided 15 t-shirts but we have more kids acting as Junior Coaches. Discussion to get vests instead of t-shirts so they can be used for the program for years to come. Looking to order 50 vests. Initial quote \$435. This will come out of the playground budget. Action. Mindy to look into DIYing this.
